

# Village of Twin Lakes

## ITEMS TO BE RECYCLED

Have your garbage and recycling out to the curb by 6:00am.

### NEWSPAPERS, MAGAZINES, OFFICE PAPER

Including glossy inserts, catalogs, mail circulars, phone books, paperback books, cereal boxes, envelopes, wrapping paper etc.

### CARDBOARD (FLATTENED)

Clean cardboard only. must be broken down, and flattened and placed inside the toter.

### GLASS (CLEAR-BROWN-GREEN)

All bottles and jars must be rinsed out. No window glass, lightbulbs, TV tubes, drinking glass, etc.

### ALUMINUM

Aluminum beverage cans only. No aluminum foil, TV dinner trays, etc.

### TIN & BI-METAL CANS

Soup, Vegetable, juice cans, etc. All cans must be rinsed out completely.

### PLASTIC CONTAINERS

This includes plastic bottles with threaded caps, the recycling symbol 1 thru 7. All plastic bottles must be rinsed out completely. **NO** deli or butter containers.

Accepting TYPE 1 through TYPE 7.

Look for the  coding on the bottom of the bottle.

### TIRES

Car Tires only. A maximum of 2 per week up to 8 per unit, per year.

### WASTE OIL

Common engine oil only. Must be in leak-proof, non-breakable containers. Limit 2 one-gallon with lid, per week.

### LEAD ACID VEHICLE BATTERIES

Car and truck batteries only. Batteries casing must be Unbroken.

Recycling is now single stream! What this means to you is no more separating!  
Every recyclable item simply has to be placed in the new 95 gallon toter supplied by Veolia.

Place your recyclables in the special recycling containers provided. These containers are to be left with the residence if you move. Waste oil and vehicle batteries should be placed along side your recycling container not inside. Please keep your recyclables separate from your other garbage and easily accessible. DNR is enforcing stronger recycling laws in the state of Wisconsin.

After January 1st the Village of Twin Lakes has switched to **Every Other Week** Recycling.  
Your recycling service will still be performed on the same day as your trash, just not every week.

**NO MEDICAL WASTE** - i.e. Needles, rubber gloves, oxygen tubes, IV bags, etc.

**NO YARD WASTE** - It is illegal to landfill these items.

**NO WET PAINT or HAZARDOUS MATERIALS** - Please contact your County regarding disposal of these items

**EMPTY or DRY PAINT CANS** - These items may be set next to your trash with the lids removed.

### HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

There will be **NO** garbage pick up on the following days:

**Thanksgiving Day \* Christmas Day \* New Year's Day \* Memorial Day \* Fourth of July**  
Collections will be one day later (working on Saturdays) when the holiday falls during the week.

One toter should be placed on each side of the drive way  
for the arm of the truck to be able to empty the toter.
