

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-11-2

An Ordinance Amending Chapter 3.06 of the Twin Lakes Code of Ordinances Pertaining to Fees, Charges, and Deposits

The President and the Trustees of the VILLAGE OF TWIN LAKES, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, do herewith ordain as follows, to wit:

SECTION I

Section 3.06.010 of the Twin Lakes Code of Ordinances pertaining to Fees, Charges and Deposits is hereby amended to read as follows:

3.06.010 Fees, Charges and Deposits.

B. ~~The Village Clerk/Treasurer shall make the following charges~~ Charges are as follows:

3. Copies of computerized records ~~on portable electronic media~~ (i.e. such as voting registration lists) ~~but not including photographs (diskette/CD supplied by Village), actual diskette/CD costs plus twenty five cents (\$.25) per page of material as if it were printed on standard eight and one half (8.5) inch by eleven (11) inch paper, electronic versions of photographs will be provided at ten dollars (\$10.00) per diskette or CD regardless of the number of images up to the capacity of the portable storage media;~~ may be copied onto a CD (supplied by the Village): ten dollars (\$10.00).

9. There shall be no charge for copies of individual real estate tax bills provided to the property owner, official minutes of the most recent meeting of any Board, Committee, Commission or other public bodies when the Village Clerk/~~Treasurer~~ is the custodian of such records;

~~11. Mailing labels (computer) set up charge: ten dollars (\$10.00); each sheet of labels: twenty five cents (\$.25);~~ Electronic distribution of computerized records: Digital audio recordings and other readily-available computerized files may be provided electronically upon request by the public or Village officials at no charge.

~~12. Duplication of Photographs:~~

~~Reproduction from print or negative ————— Ten dollars (\$10.00) plus actual production cost~~

~~Reproduction from digital format ————— Ten dollars (\$10.00) plus actual production cost~~

SECTION II

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-11-3

An Ordinance Amending Chapter 2.48 of the Twin Lakes Code of Ordinances Pertaining to Police Department and Police Commission

The President and the Trustees of the VILLAGE OF TWIN LAKES, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, do herewith ordain as follows, to wit:

SECTION I

Section 2.48.090 of the Twin Lakes Code of Ordinances pertaining to Employment Examinations is hereby amended to read as follows:

D. Examination for the eligible list for appointment as Police Officer shall be ~~free~~ for U.S. citizens over eighteen (18) and under fifty-five (55) years of age, with proper limitations as to residence, health and subject to Sections 111.321, 111.322 and 111.335 of the Wisconsin Statutes, arrest and conviction record. Examinations for position of Chief of Police shall be for U.S. citizens over thirty (30) years of age at the time of the examination with not less than ten (10) years prior experience in law enforcement, with proper limitations as to residence, health, and subject to Sections 111.321, 111.322 and 111.335 of the Wisconsin Statutes, arrest and conviction record. *Applicants to any Police Department position shall provide payment at time of application submittal for the cost of the employment examination. Failure to provide the examination payment at time of application submittal shall render the application incomplete and thus ineligible for employment.* Selection of Police Officers for the Police Department shall be made only from an eligible list provided by the Police Commission.

SECTION II

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances contravening the terms and conditions of this Ordinance are hereby to that extent repealed.

SECTION III

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as provided by law, and the Village Clerk shall so amend the Village of Twin Lakes Code of Ordinances, and shall indicate the date and number of this creating Ordinance therein.
