

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT PARTICIPATION IN SUBURBAN MUTUAL ASSISTANCE RESPONSE TEAMS

WHEREAS, the Suburban Mutual Assistance Response Teams (“S.M.A.R.T”) have effectively provided law enforcement mutual aid to its participants since 1994; and

WHEREAS, the S.M.A.R.T. Mutual Aid Agreement is in need of updating to address certain inconsistencies within the terms and due to changes in the law; and


WHEREAS, we have received a recommendation from our Chief Executive Law Enforcement Officer, recommending that we enter the S.M.A.R.T. Mutual Aid Agreement which will update and replace the current Agreement and allow for our continued participation in this cooperative mutual aid, to better serve our municipality and region.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Village of Twin Lakes authorizes the Village Administrator, Clerk, and the Police Chief to execute the agreement, a copy of which is attached to this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all Village of Twin Lakes Police Department officials and employees are hereby authorized and directed to do and perform all that is necessary to successfully carry out the terms of this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
