

## ORDINANCE NO. 2019-3-1

### An Ordinance Amending Chapter 13.04 Of The Twin Lakes Code Of Ordinances Pertaining to Water Softeners

The President and the Trustees of the VILLAGE OF TWIN LAKES, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, do herewith ordain as follows, to wit:

#### SECTION I

Chapter 13.04 of the Twin Lakes Code of Ordinances, pertaining to Sewer Use and Service Charge, is hereby amended to add new subsection (E) as follows:

#### 13.04.030 Use Of The Public Sewers.

E. Water Softeners. Any residential, commercial, or industrial user installing a new or replacement ion-exchange device used primarily for water hardness reduction that, during regeneration, discharges a brine solution (i.e., a "water softener") may only install a demand-initiated regeneration-type water softener equipped with a water meter or a sensor. New timer-based water softeners are prohibited.

#### SECTION II

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances contravening the terms and conditions of this Ordinance are hereby to that extent repealed.

#### SECTION III

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as provided by law, and the Village Clerk/Treasurer shall so amend the Village of Twin Lakes Code of Ordinances, and shall indicate the date and number of this creating Ordinance therein.

## ORDINANCE NO. 2019-3-2

### An Ordinance Amending Section 10.28 Of The Twin Lakes Code Of Ordinances Pertaining to Stop Streets and Parking Limitations

The President and the Trustees of the VILLAGE OF TWIN LAKES, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, do herewith ordain as follows, to wit:

#### SECTION I

Section 10.28.070 of the Twin Lakes Code of Ordinances pertaining to Stop Streets is hereby amended to read as follows:

#### **10.28.070 Stop Streets.**

All vehicles shall come to a complete stop before entering or proceeding on streets or intersections that have posted stop signs. All stop signs shall be approved by a majority vote of the Village Board prior to posting, and a master list of all approved stop signs shall be maintained by the Village Clerk/Treasurer at the Village Hall. (Ord. 92-1-2).

#### SCHOORS LANE

Vehicles traveling East shall stop before entering the intersection of Matthew Avenue

#### SECTION II

All Ordinance or parts of Ordinances contravening the terms and conditions of this Ordinance are hereby to that extent repealed.


#### SECTION III

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 2019-3-3

**A Charter Ordinance to Amend Sections 2.26 and 2.27 of the Village of Twin Lakes  
Municipal Code of Ordinances  
Related to Combining the Offices of Village Clerk and Village Treasurer**

The President and the Trustees of the VILLAGE OF TWIN LAKES, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, do herewith ordain as follows:

**SECTION I**

Pursuant to Sections 61.195 and 66.0101 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Village of Twin Lakes hereby elects to combine the offices of Village Clerk and Village Treasurer that were previously separated under Charter Ordinance 2014-10-1, and further elects not to be governed by those provisions of Sections 61.19, 61.23, 61.25 and 61.26 of the Wisconsin Statutes that are in conflict with this ordinance.

**SECTION II**

Section 2.26 of the Village of Twin Lakes Municipal Code of Ordinances pertaining to the Village Clerk is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

**Chapter 2.26**

**VILLAGE CLERK/TREASURER**

**2.26.010 Appointment.**

The Village Administrator shall assist the Village Board to identify qualified candidates and creating a list of the recommended candidates for possible appointment to the office of Village Clerk/**Treasurer**. The Village Clerk/**Treasurer** shall be appointed by the Village Board, after considering the input of the Village Administrator into the decision. ~~The incumbent Village Clerk/Treasurer shall continue to serve as Village Clerk until the appointment and qualification of a successor.~~

**2.26.020 Term of Office.**

The appointed Village Clerk/**Treasurer** shall hold office for an indefinite term, subject to removal as provided in Section 17.13 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

**2.26.030 Duties.**

The Village Clerk/**Treasurer** shall perform all duties required of the office of the Village Clerk **and Village Treasurer** as provided by law and those other duties as the Village Board or Village Administrator directs to be executed by the Village Clerk/**Treasurer** from time to time.

**2.26.040 Minutes of Meetings.**

Within not more than fourteen (14) days after each meeting of the Village Board, the Village Clerk shall supply to the Village President and Village Trustees, a printed copy of the proceedings thereof. For all other Committees or Commission, the Village Clerk shall supply a printed copy of the most recent proceedings thereof within twenty-one (21) days following each meeting of said Committee or Commission.

**2.26.050 Annual Audit.**

Annual audits shall be made of the records of Village Clerk/Treasurer by a certified public accountant.

**SECTION III**

Section 2.27 of the Village of Twin Lakes Municipal Code of Ordinances pertaining to the Village Accountant/Treasurer is hereby repealed.

**SECTION IV**

Should any section, clause or provision of this charter ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part so declared to be invalid.

**SECTION V**

All ordinances in conflict with any of the provisions of this charter ordinance are hereby repealed.

**SECTION VI**

This Charter Ordinance shall take effect sixty (60) days after its passage and publication unless within such sixty (60) day period a referendum petition as provided by Section 66.0101(5) of the Wisconsin Statutes shall be filed, in which event this ordinance shall not take effect until it shall have been submitted to a referendum vote of the electors and approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

This charter ordinance was approved by at least a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Village Board on this 18<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2019.
