



ORDINANCE NO. 2019-7-1

An Ordinance Amending Chapter 5.08 Of The Twin Lakes Code Of Ordinances Pertaining to Exhibitions, Shows and Amusements

The President and the Trustees of the VILLAGE OF TWIN LAKES, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, do herewith ordain as follows, to wit:

SECTION I

Chapter 5.08.020 of the Twin Lakes Code of Ordinances pertaining to License Application and Fee be, and hereby is, amended to read as follows:

5.08.020 License Application and Fee.

Any person or persons within the provisions of Section 5.08.010 shall, prior to engaging in any such exhibition or putting on any show or amusement, make application to the Village Clerk for a license thereof. Said application shall be in writing and signed by the person or persons making such application and the person or persons making application shall pay a license fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) to the Village Treasurer. Churches, service organizations, **seasonal businesses**, and any other not for profit organizations duly licensed by the State, shall pay a license fee of one dollar (\$1.00). All persons making application for said license, at the time of application, shall file with the Village Clerk adequate evidence that sufficient liability insurance coverage is provided for the protection of the public.

SECTION II

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances contravening the terms and conditions of this Ordinance are hereby to that extent repealed.

SECTION III



ORDINANCE NO. 2019-7-2

An Ordinance Amending Chapter 17.12.101 Of The Twin Lakes Code Of Ordinances Pertaining to Fence.

The President and the Trustees of the VILLAGE OF TWIN LAKES, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, do herewith ordain as follows, to wit:

SECTION I

Chapter 17.12.101 of the Twin Lakes Code of Ordinances pertaining to Fence be, and hereby is, amended to read as follows:

17.12.101 Fence.

F. Fences in ALL DISTRICTS

1. Security fences or walls are permitted in all districts other than Residential Districts. Security fences or walls may be placed on side and rear property lines, but shall not be located closer than two (2) feet to a public right-of-way line. Security fences or walls shall not exceed ten (10) feet in height. No fence or walls greater than two (2) feet in height shall be placed within the vision triangle.

2. Any fence or hedgerow in a commercial or Industrial District shall comply with the provisions of subsection D(1) of this Section. Fences in commercial and Industrial Districts may be solid, chain link or open woven wire. The use of electrically charged fences, ~~is prohibited and the use of~~ barb wire or spike fences is prohibited except as upon approval by the Village Board.

SECTION II

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances contravening the terms and conditions of this Ordinance are hereby to that extent repealed.

SECTION III


