

## ORDINANCE NO. 2020-5-1

### An Ordinance Amending Subsection 5.20.050 Of The Twin Lakes Code Of Ordinances Pertaining To Alcohol Operator Licenses

The President and the Trustees of the VILLAGE OF TWIN LAKES, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, do herewith ordain as follows, to wit:

#### SECTION I

Chapter 5.20 of the Twin Lakes Code of Ordinances, pertaining to operator's licenses, is hereby amended to add new Subsection 5.20.050 (F) as follows:

#### **5.20.050 License Application.**

"F. Village Clerk Authority to Issue Operator's Licenses. Upon satisfaction of the requirements of this Chapter 5.20 and applicable state laws, and subject to the restrictions set forth therein, the Village Clerk is authorized to issue new or renewed operator's licenses, provisional operator's licenses, and/or temporary operator's licenses without obtaining Village Board approval. The Village Clerk shall report to the Village Board all operator's licenses, temporary operator's license and/or provisional operator's license issued by the Village Clerk since the last Village Board meeting. Notwithstanding the above, the Village Clerk may refer any license application to the Village Board for consideration and action, and shall refer any application to the Village Board for consideration and action if the Village Clerk concludes such application should be denied."

#### SECTION II

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances contravening the terms and conditions of this Ordinance are hereby to that extent repealed.

#### SECTION III

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as provided by law, and the Village Clerk/Treasurer shall so amend the Village of Twin Lakes Code of Ordinances, and shall indicate the date and number of this creating Ordinance therein.


