ORDINANCE NO. 2020-10-1

An Ordinance Creating
Subsection 14.04.100 Of The Twin Lakes Code Of Ordinances Pertaining Adoption of the
Wisconsin Administrative Electrical Code

The President and the Trustees of the VILLAGE OF TWIN LAKES, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, do herewith ordain as follows, to wit:

SECTION I

Chapter 14.04 of the Twin Lakes Code of Ordinances, pertaining General Provisions as to Buildings and Construction, is amended to create new Subsection 14.04.100 as follows:

14.04.100 Adoption of Wisconsin Administrative Electrical Code.

“The provisions of Chapter SPS 316 (Electrical) of the Administrative Code of the State of Wisconsin, as may be amended from time to time, are hereby adopted and, by reference, made a part of this Chapter as if fully set forth herein. Any act required to be performed, or prohibited, by said Administrative Code Chapter SPS 316 is required and prohibited by this section as well. Fees shall be imposed for all required permits in such amounts as are set periodically by the Village Board. In the event of any conflict between any provision of this Chapter, and Wisconsin Administrative Code SPS 316, the Administrative Code provision shall control. It is the intention of the Village Board that a duly-qualified Village building inspector shall directly undertake commercial electrical inspections and permitting pursuant to Wisconsin Administrative Code SPS 316 on behalf of the Village.”

SECTION II

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances contravening the terms and conditions of this Ordinance are hereby to that extent repealed.

SECTION III

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as provided by law, and the Village Clerk shall so amend the Village of Twin Lakes Code of Ordinances, and shall indicate the date and number of this creating Ordinance therein.
