ORDINANCE NO. 2020-6-1

An Ordinance Amending

Subsection 11.04.080 Of The Twin Lakes Code Of Ordinances Pertaining To Street Bonds

The President and the Trustees of the VILLAGE OF TWIN LAKES, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, do herewith ordain as follows, to wit:

SECTION I

Chapter 11.04 of the Twin Lakes Code of Ordinances, pertaining to street cuts, is hereby amended to revise Subsection 11.04.080 as follows:

"11.04.080 Bond Requirement.

Before any permit shall be granted, a cash bond in the sum of \$5,000 shall be posted for the performance of Sections 11.04.050 through 11.04.070 and 11.05.115 each opening shall be considered separately and a bond posted for each. No opening shall remain open without approved warning. The Village reserves the right to require a higher bond if, in the reasonable opinion of the Village's engineer or public works foreman, the scope or risk of a particular project necessitates a higher bond amount. The bond shall be held to ensure the applicant's completion and restoration of all public facilities in a manner satisfactory to the Village. If such work is not completed within a reasonable time, or if any deficiencies are not remedied within 5 business days' notice from the Village to the applicant and to the property owner, the Village may without further notice and without recourse draw on the posted bond amount to restore the Village's facilities. Any bond amount remaining after proper restoration of the Village's facilities shall be returned to the person or entity who posted he bond. If the bond amount is inadequate to cover the costs of restoration of the Village's facilities, the applicant shall pay the Village the difference within 5 business days' notice to the applicant and to the property owner. In addition to or in lieu of any other action the Village may take, any deficiency that remains unpaid may be assessed as a special charge against the property that was benefited by the application."

SECTION II

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances contravening the terms and conditions of this Ordinance are hereby to that extent repealed.

SECTION III

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as provided by law, and the Village Clerk/Treasurer shall so amend the Village of Twin Lakes Code of Ordinances, and shall indicate the date and number of this creating Ordinance therein.
