Village of Twin Lakes RESOLUTION NO. R2020-9-4 DECLARATION OF OFFICIAL INTENT TO REIMBURSE EXPENDITURES FOR CLEAN WATER FUND (CWF)

WHEREAS, the Village of Twin Lakes, Kenosha County, Wisconsin (the "Municipality") owns and operates a wastewater collection, conveyance, and treatment system (the "System") as a public utility; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality plans to perform modifications to its System (the "Project"); and WHEREAS, the Municipality expects to receive a loan (the "Loan") from the Clean Water Fund (the "CWF") to finance the Project and expects to issue tax-exempt bonds (the "Bonds") to the Program in evidence of the Loan; and

WHEREAS, because the Loan will not become available prior to June 2021, the Municipality must provide interim financing to cover costs of the Project incurred prior to receipt of the Loan; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary, desirable, and in the best interests of the Municipality to advance moneys from its funds on hand on an interim basis until the Loan becomes available and the Bonds can be issued.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village of Twin Lakes, Kenosha County, Wisconsin that:

Section 1. Expenditure of Funds. The Municipality shall make expenditures as needed from existing municipal accounts that contain ordinary municipal revenue to pay the costs of the Project until Bond proceeds become available.

Section 2. Declaration of Official Intent. The Municipality hereby officially declares its intent under 26 CFR Section 1.150-2 to reimburse said expenditures with proceeds of the Bonds, the principal amount of which is not expected to exceed \$13.67 Million.

Section 3. Unavailability of Long-Term Funds. No funds for payment of the Project from sources other than the Bonds are or are reasonably expected to be reserved, allocated on a long-term basis, or otherwise set aside by the Municipality pursuant to its budget or financial policies.

Section 4. Public Availability of Official Intent Resolution. This Resolution shall be made available for public inspection at the Municipal Clerk's office within 30 days after its approval in compliance with applicable State laws governing the availability of records of official acts and shall remain available for public inspection until the Bonds are issued.

Section 5. Effective Date. This resolution shall be effective upon its adoption and approval.

RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE SALE OF APPROXIMATELY \$1,315,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION REFUNDING BONDS

WHEREAS, the Village of Twin Lakes, Kenosha County, Wisconsin (the "Village") is presently in need of approximately \$1,315,000 for the public purpose of refunding certain outstanding obligations of the Village, specifically, the State Trust Fund Loan, dated February 14, 2017 and the State Trust Fund Loan, dated April 30, 2019; and

("Ehlers")) be and hereby is directed to cause notice of the sale of the Bonds to be disseminated in such manner and at such times as the Village Clerk may determine and to cause copies of a complete Notice of Sale and other pertinent data to be forwarded to interested bidders as the Village Clerk may determine.

Section 4. Official Statement. The Village Clerk (in consultation with Ehlers) shall cause an Official Statement to be prepared and distributed. The appropriate Village officials shall determine when the Official Statement is final for purposes of Securities and Exchange Commission Rule 15c2-12 and shall certify said Official Statement, such certification to constitute full authorization of such Official Statement under this resolution.
