ORDINANCE NO. 2021-11-3

An Ordinance Creating Chapter 10.46. Of The Twin Lakes Code Of Ordinances Pertaining To All-Terrain Vehicles, Utility Terrain Vehicles, Off-Highway Motorcycles, Minibikes and Trail Bikes

The President and the Trustees of the VILLAGE OF TWIN LAKES, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, do herewith ordain as follows, to wit:

SECTION I

Chapter 10.46 of Title 10 (Vehicles and Traffic) of the Twin Lakes Code of Ordinances, pertaining to All-Terrain Vehicles, Utility Terrain Vehicles, Off-Highway Motorcycles, Minibikes, and Trail Bikes, is hereby created to read as follows:

“Chapter 10.46

**All-Terrain Vehicles, Utility Terrain Vehicles, Off-Highway Motorcycles,
Minibikes and Trail Bikes**

10.46.010 All-Terrain Vehicle, Utility Terrain Vehicle, and Off-Highway Motorcycle State Laws Adopted.

All provisions of Wis. Stats. Chapter 23.33, pertaining to all-terrain vehicles and utility terrain vehicles, and all provisions of Wis. Stats. Chapter 23.335, pertaining to off-highway motorcycles, and all administrative code sections pertaining to said sections, are hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this Code as if fully set forth herein. Any act required to be performed or prohibited by any state law incorporated herein by reference is required or prohibited by this Code. Any future amendments, revisions, or modifications of the statutes or administrative code sections incorporated herein are intended to be automatically made and incorporated as a part of this Code.

10.46.020 Operation On Owner’s Premises

Minibikes, trail bikes, all-terrain vehicles, utility terrain vehicles, off-highway motorcycles, and all similar small, motorized vehicles may be operated on the premises owned by the operator or member of the family of the operator if such operator resides on the premises where such vehicle is being operated or on the property of another with the property owner’s written permission. Operation of such vehicle shall be confined to those hours between 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. Notwithstanding the above, no such vehicle may be operated on any property that is one acre in size or less, unless the property is part of an approved trail system.

10.46.030 Nuisance prohibited.

No minibike, trail bike, all-terrain vehicle, utility terrain vehicle, off-highway motorcycle, or similar small, motorized vehicle may be operated under this Chapter if the operation is such that the noise and/or dust from the vehicle causes a disturbance or annoyance to other persons residing near the vehicle operation, if the vehicle operation unreasonably interferes with the complainant's quiet enjoyment of such person's property.

SECTION II

Section 10.44.051, partially incorporating prior all-terrain vehicle law, is hereby repealed.

SECTION III

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances contravening the terms and conditions of this Ordinance are hereby to that extent repealed.

SECTION IV

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as provided by law, and the Village Clerk/Treasurer shall so amend the Village of Twin Lakes Code of Ordinances and shall indicate the date and number of this creating Ordinance therein.
