PUBLIC COMMENTS AND QUESTIONS

Lynn Garnand, 1505 Richmond Rd, questioned an open house for the new Village Hall.

Meredith Kurtzweil, 324 Meadow Ct, introduced herself as she is a candidate on the April ballot for Randall School Board.

Bob Wagner, 234 Christie Ln, questioned how many people are in Trevor-Wilmot School District.

Christine Fauria, 545 Arrowhead, requested the board take into consideration that snow blowers do not fall under the unnecessary noise violation. Her husband was snow blowing for the neighbors and the police were called due to unnecessary noise.

Izabela Jones, 353 Hillview Ct, asked the village contact 319 Bassett St to clean up the residence as it looks like a junk yard. She also requested the broken laundromat windows be fixed as it looks bad in the downtown.

Cheree Molitor, 2020 60th Ave, has concerns with the building and zoning codes 17.12.140, one building one lot, 17.12.160, accessory use structures, and 17.20, residential district. She owns 11 acres of farmland where she built a new home and pole barn. She applied for a second additional pole barn and was denied by the Building Inspector based on how the code reads. She applied for a variance and was again denied by the Zoning Board of Appeals as she could not show a hardship. She is requesting the board consider an amendment to the code to clarify so it is not misinterpreted and to allow additional accessory structures. She would like to still farm the last 7 or 8 acres.
