MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF TWIN LAKES AND KENOSHA COUNTY HIGHWAYS DEPARTMENT REGARDING SIDEWALK INDEMNIFICATION AND MAINTENANCE

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING, effective as of the date last executed by either party below, made and entered into by and between **KENOSHA COUNTY HIGHWAY DIVISION**, a division of Kenosha County, a quasi-municipal corporation with its highway department offices located at 19600 75th Street, Suite 122-1, Bristol, WI 53104 ("County"), and the **VILLAGE OF TWIN LAKES**, a municipal corporation with offices located at 108 E. Main Street, Twin Lakes, Wisconsin, 53181 ("Village") (collectively "the Parties").

WHEREAS, the Village is in the process of building a new village hall; and,

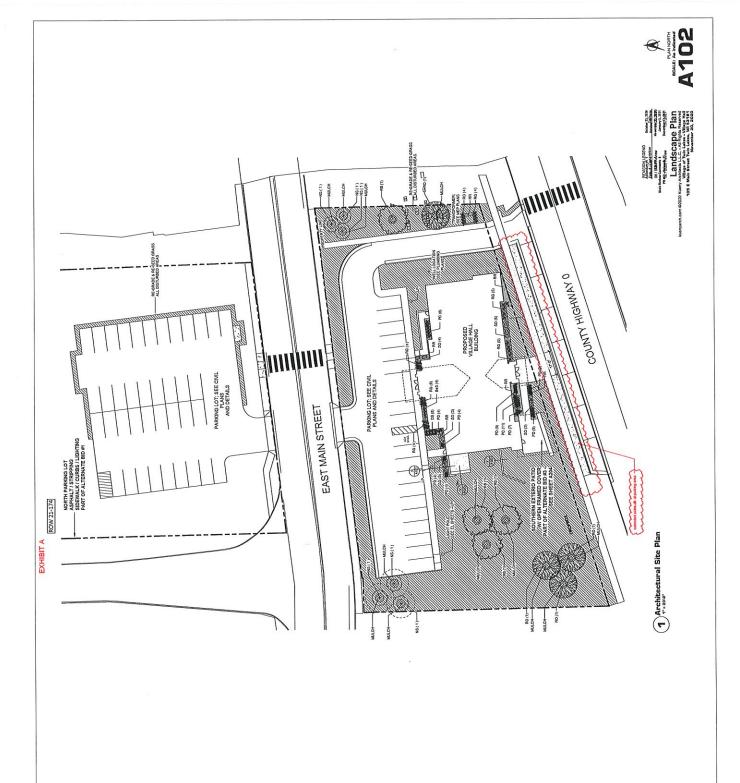
WHEREAS, in order to afford better public access to the new facility, the Village has requested that the County allow the Village to widen a section of sidewalk in the County's right-of-way abutting the new village hall, as depicted and described in Exhibit A hereto ("Widened Sidewalk"); and,

WHEREAS, the County has indicated its willingness to allow the Widened Sidewalk, provided that the Village agrees to indemnify the County as to the Widened Sidewalk and to accept responsibility for maintaining it.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises herein, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. The Village shall construct or arrange for the construction of the Widened Sidewalk in compliance with the terms and conditions of the right-of-way permit issued by the County and any/all applicable County construction specifications.
- 3. Upon completion of the Widened Sidewalk, all responsibility for on-going maintenance thereof shall belong to the Village, including, without limitation by enumeration, responsibility for snow and ice removal, crackfilling, and replacement. The Village shall maintain the sidewalk in a safe condition, but the Village reserves the right to assert, as against any sidewalk-related claimant, any and all factual and/or legal defenses or immunities available to it.
- 4. The Village agrees to, and hereby does, indemnify and hold harmless the County from and against any liability for any damage that may be done to the Widened Sidewalk by the County or by any of County's contractors during the course of any right-of-way maintenance work.

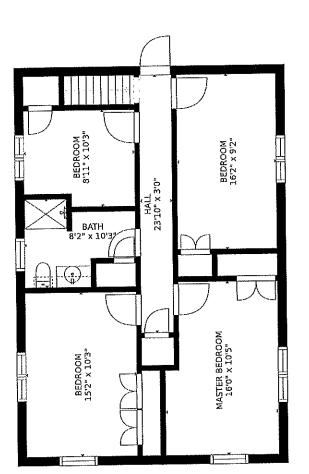

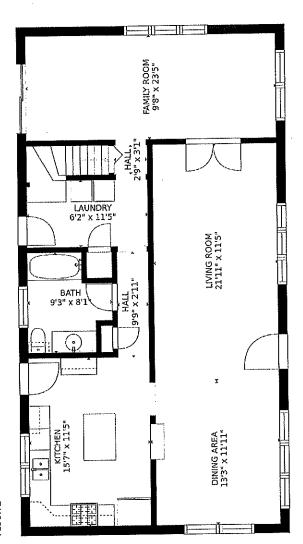

Ammunition Shortage Update 2022 IMPORTANT INFORMATION To all Sheriffs, Chiefs, Correctional institutions, and Training Staff:

We understand your frustration. By now ammunition shortages have affected most agencies, and progress has been slow. I'd like to take a moment to review where the industry stands today and where we're headed. First, the good news: ammunition availability is generally improving though with some environmental calibers, however, there is still a long lead time as we await orders to be filled. The bad news is that all ammunition prices are skyrocketing and will continue to escalate through 2022. Because I'm frequently asked why prices continue to increase so much, I wanted to share some of the reasons:

• Two years ago, copper was around \$2.75/lb. As I write this letter it's \$4.42/lb. Some brokers say copper could hit \$6.00/lb. by the end of 2022. This is due to several factors: pandemic recovery, new electric cars, car charging stations, and the demands of a rebounding economy.

· In recent years the price of lead has doubled, and demand for electric cars/batteries will only esca-

late it further.

• Virtually no lead is produced in the United States other than for recycled batteries, and very little copper is domestically produced, thus requiring imports for both materials.

• Since almost all lead and most copper is imported, consider for a moment how that impacts pricing: container and shipping costs + port costs + delivery delays have dramatically escalated previous costs.

• Ammunition is mostly lead and copper by weight, which is heavy. Increasing fuel prices have therefore driven freight delivery costs up significantly.

Kiesler's has been notified by several of our ammunition manufacturers that another price increase will happen April 1st, 2022. There can and most likely will be additional increases this year.

How can departments, agencies, and correctional institutions mitigate these huge price increases? The very simple answer is to order now, especially ahead of the April 1st increases. We can guarantee today's prices for any order that meets drop-ship requirements and is received/processed before April 1st. If your department's budget can sustain a larger purchase, it would be financially beneficial to order an extra year's supply. Shock waves to training budgets are going to get worse and this should help lessen the blow. This is not a ploy to get larger orders or for Kiesler's to make more profit. Our advice is intended to help agencies save money.

Even if your department isn't a Kiesler customer, you should place orders now from the distributor/manufacturer you are currently utilizing. Waiting may be a financially costly mistake.

September of 2022 will mark Kiesler's 50th year of being in business. Never in those 50 years have we had so many problems making on-time deliveries. For that I greatly apologize. Deliveries may still not be good, but at least departments can lock in prices now.

The 2021 Wastewater Upgrades at the Village's wastewater treatment facility and lift stations was awarded to Joseph J. Henderson & Sons, Inc. (JJH) in May, 2021. This month the contractor has completed the following elements of the project and requests payment:

- Ongoing project management and site supervision of the project work.
- Preparation of the aggregate base for the new garage and retaining wall.
- Delivery of the structural steel and trusses for the new garage.
- Delivery of new pumps, piping, valves, fittings, and flow control gates for the project to be installed later this year.
- Installation of valves in two of the lift stations.
- Ongoing progress work by the electricians installing new conduit in the office and RAS control buildings.

Town and Country Engineering has reviewed Invoice #81895 (Pay Request #8) in the amount of \$379,984.67 and recommends payment by the Village. This payment reflects the payment terms of the signed agreement, including retainage of 5% of the completed work amount. Per the agreement, work is to be substantially complete late this year. Invoices for the remaining portion of this project will continue on a monthly basis.

LIABILITY INSURANCE REQUIREMENT

The applicant or special event sponsoring shall supply the Village with a certificate of insurance demonstrating the required level of insurance coverage in addition to providing the Village with a copy of the insurance policy endorsement language demonstrating that the Village, its officers, agents, employees and contractors are named and endorsed as an additional insured party. Certificate must show Comprehensive General Liability Insurance with coverage for contractual liability with limits no less than \$1,000,000 each occurrence for comprehensive general liability insurance and, \$2,000,000 aggregate limits for bodily injury and property damage, unless otherwise specified by the Village. The Village Board may require a higher limit depending upon the details of the special event, which may include:

- (1) A special event that includes alcohol, or,
- (2) A special event that is anticipated to have attendance greater than 100 people per day, or,
- (3) A multi-day special event.

Proof of this insurance is required to be turned into the Village no less than ten (10) days prior to the start of the special event. If any modifications occur to the insurance terms, the applicant must also notify the Village immediately. Any change to coverage requires Village approval. Also, if coverage is canceled or no longer meets the Village's requirements, the special event permit will be rescinded. The applicant shall also agree to hold the Village, its officers, employees, agents, and contractors harmless against all claims, liability, loss, damage, or expense (including but not limited to actual attorney's fees) incurred by the Village for any damage or injury to a person or property caused by or resulting directly or indirectly from the activities for which the special event permit is granted.

Upon approval, the permit issued by the VILLAGE OF TWIN LAKES authorizes the applicant to conduct the event described in the application and the applicant hereby agrees to comply with all applicable laws, rules and regulations, including any restrictions or conditions imposed by the Village, affecting the holding of an event. The applicant acknowledges and understands that the VILLAGE OF TWIN LAKES reserves the right to cancel any permit for non-compliance by the applicant with the restrictions or conditions imposed by the Village in approving the application or for violating any laws, rules or regulations.
